

Chino Hills High School agree's with CIF's Mission Statement in that we welcome athletic excellence and the shared educational experience of competition. We believe and encourage healthy competition of our athletes and we believe in pushing every athlete to success. Chino Hills High School believes in being good stewards of public funds as our public has entrusted us with being wise with how their money is spent and we **most** certainly believe that every athlete is a student first.

Currently, we are asking our students to leave class 20 minutes in to their 5th period class. This allows our students to fight traffic so they may arrive on time for a 4:45pm game. Thus, we are asking approximately 1300 student athletes to experience an 80 minute excessive loss of instructional time. Additionally, these same students arrive back on campus as late as 9pm on a school night. This is NOT in the best interest of any student.

Just as students have to leave early, so does administration. Administration must leave prior to the end of the academic day so they may travel on some occasions 31 miles away. Consequently, this leaves our campus of 2,870 students with minimal site supervision before the academic day ends. This poses a safety concern for our community.

CHHS is not being allowed to be good stewards of public funds as our transportation costs for league events have increased since joining the Baseline League.

Chino Hills High School is currently asking for an area realignment. Not voting in favor of this request is blatantly voting AGAINST what is BEST for students and their education.
